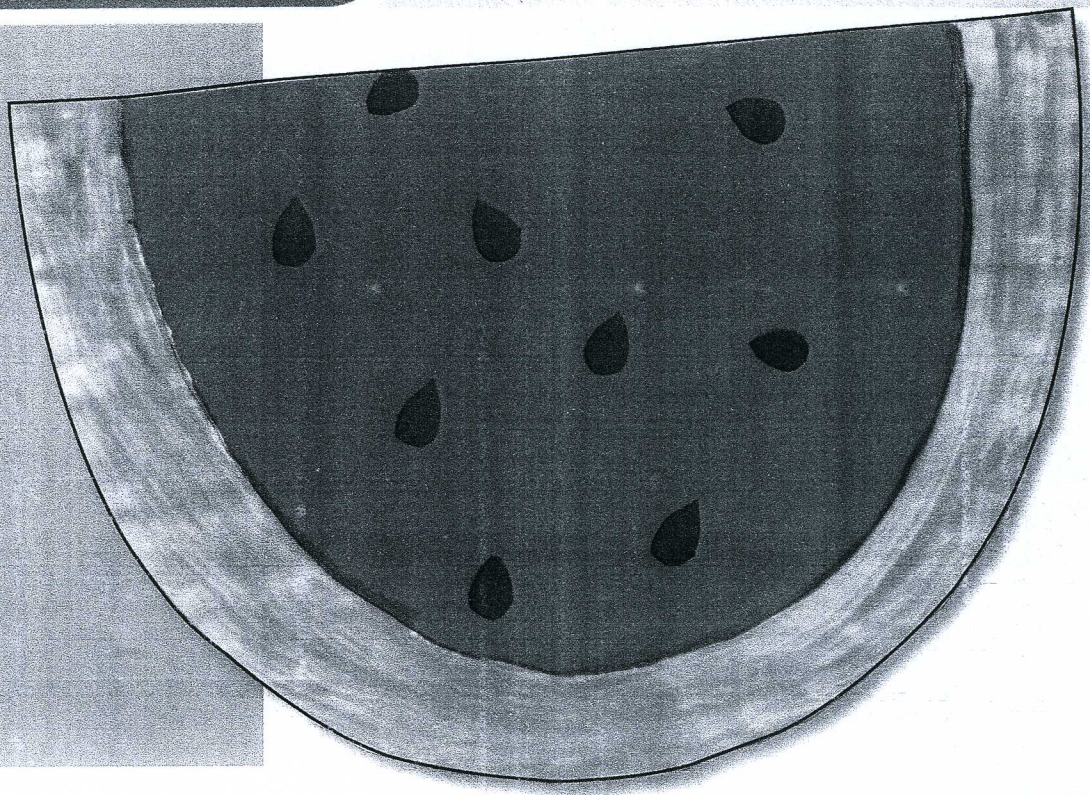


W Watermelon



Materials:

white construction paper copy of
page 95
sugar-free gelatin powder
(watermelon, lime)
black construction paper scraps
2 plastic bowls

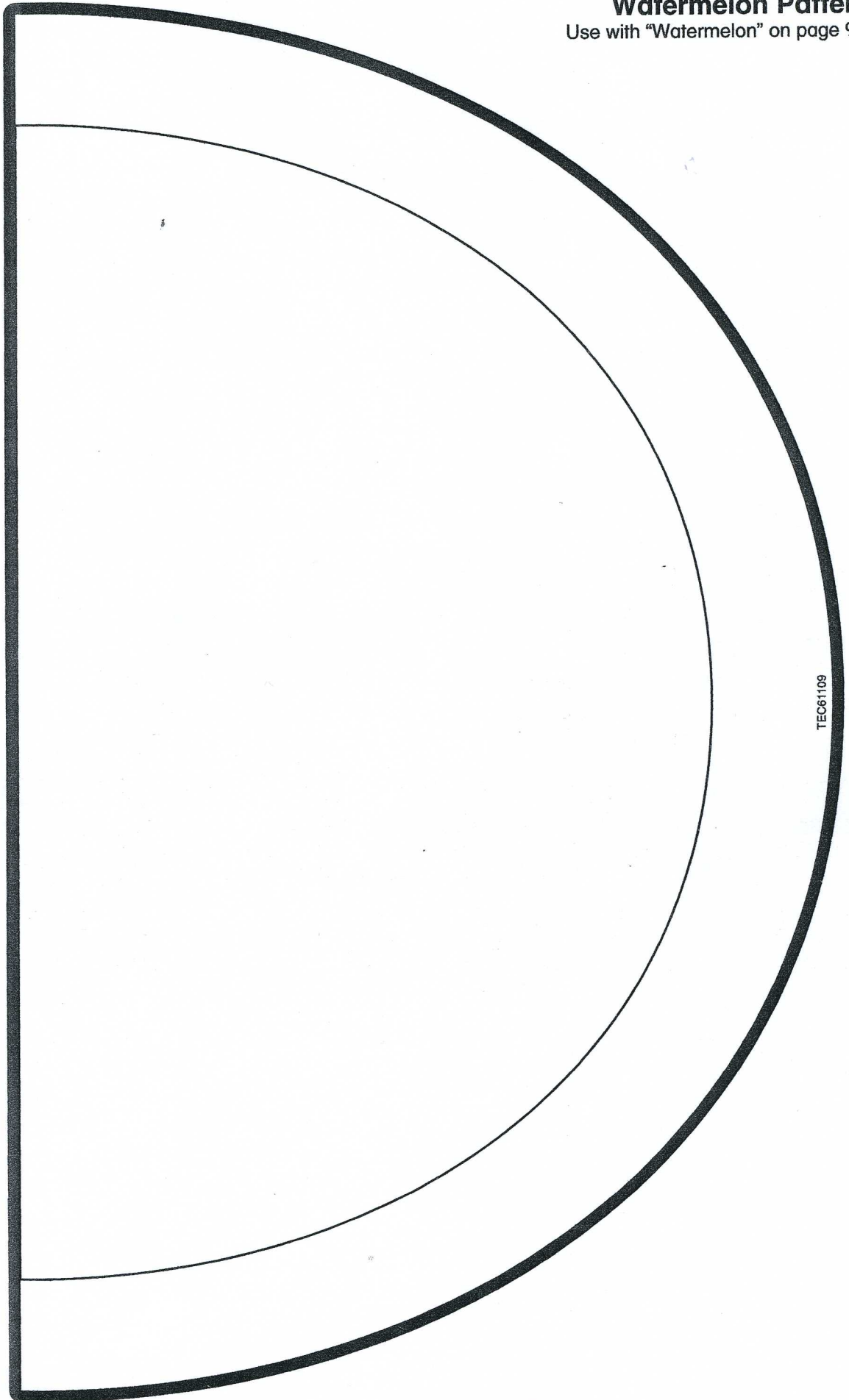
tablespoon
boiling water
scissors
paintbrushes
glue

Directions:

Put three tablespoons of gelatin powder in a plastic bowl. Stir nine tablespoons of boiling water with the gelatin until it dissolves. (The previous step is to be completed by the teacher only.) Repeat the process with the remaining gelatin flavor. Then let the resulting paint cool slightly. (Be sure to use the paint within 30 minutes or it will begin to set.) Paint the watermelon pattern. When the paint is dry, cut seeds from the black paper and glue them to the watermelon slice.
