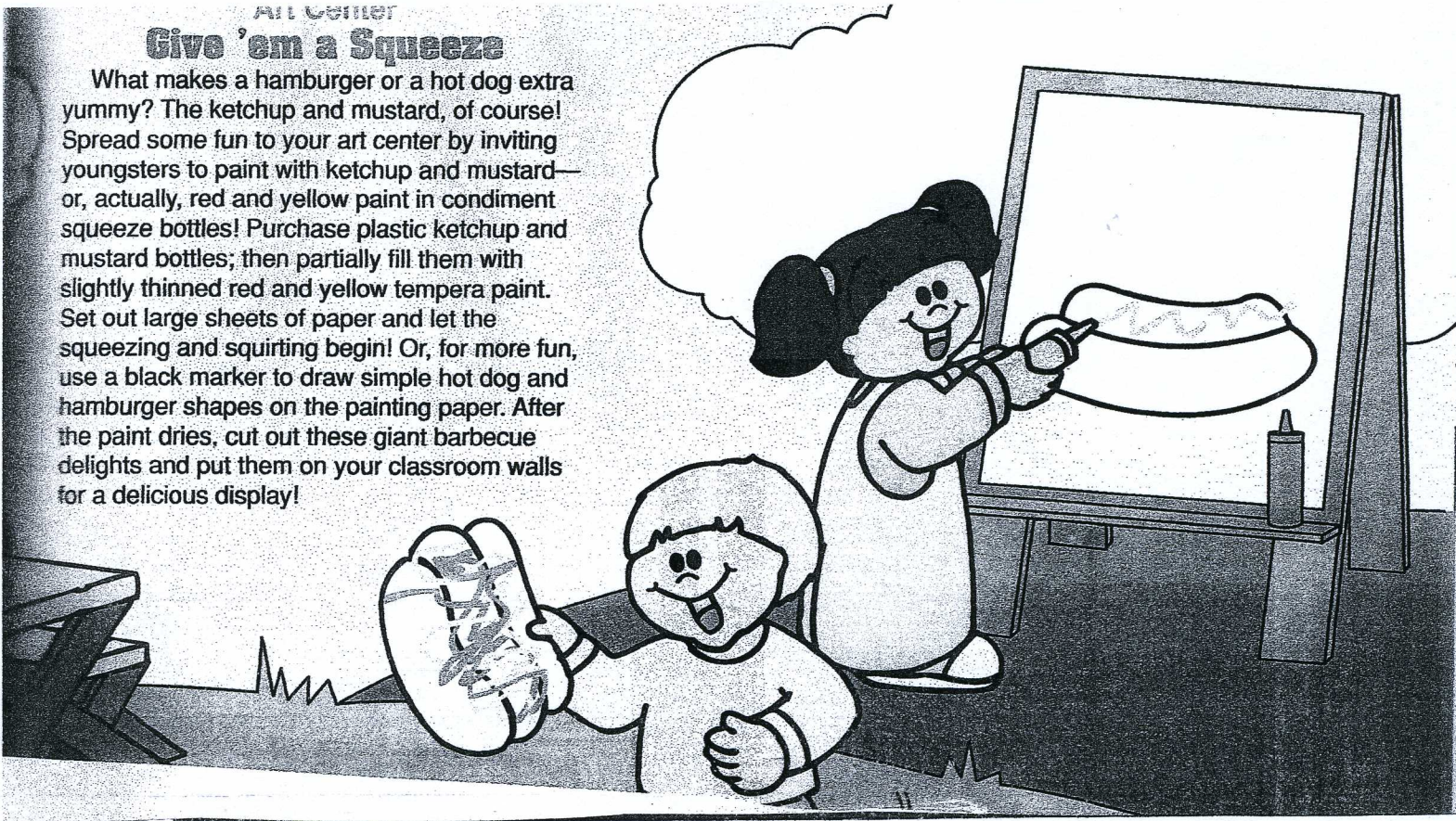


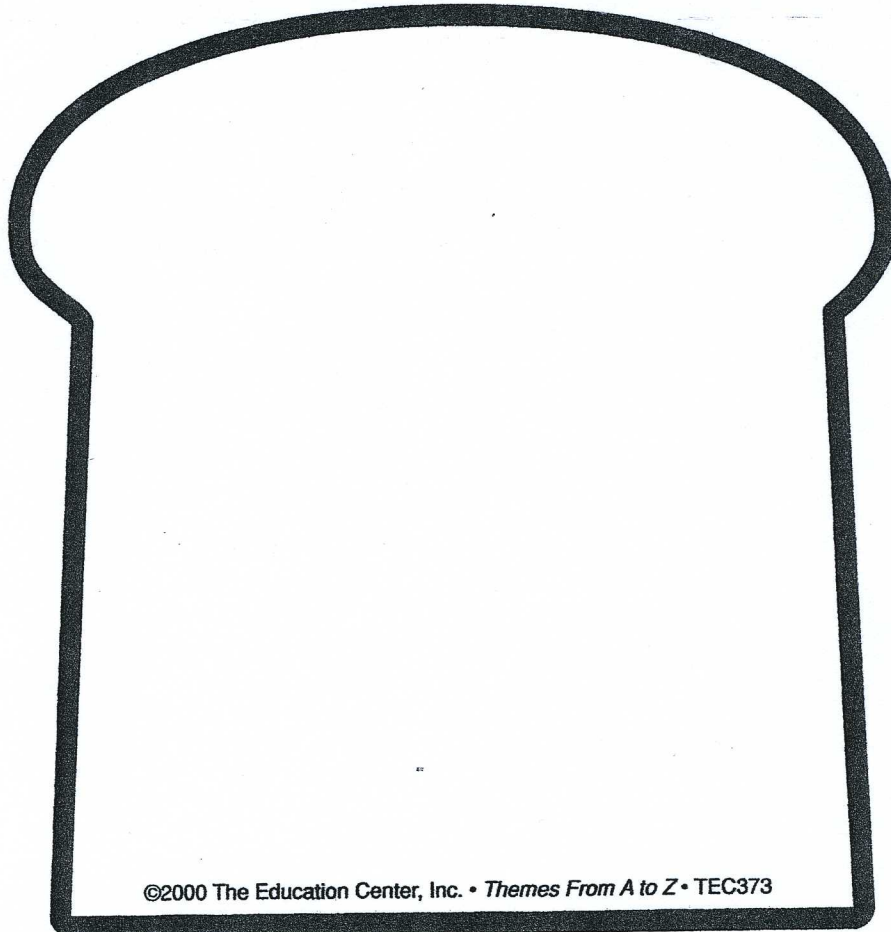
### Give 'em a Squeeze

Or, for more fun, use a black marker to draw simple hot dog and hamburger shapes on the painting paper. After the paint dries, cut out these giant barbecue delights and put them on your classroom walls for a delicious display!
